



Dr. James F. Brennan has been Provost and Chief Academic Officer for The Catholic University of America since June. As such, he is responsible for the academic quality of all of the university's programs as well as the evaluation of all of the faculty of the University. Prior to joining CUA, Dr. Brennan was Provost of Towson University of the University System of Maryland, Dean of Arts & Sciences at the University of Louisville, and Dean of the Graduate School of Loyola University Chicago. He served the University of Massachusetts at Boston for 20 years as a faculty member, including five years as Chair of that institution's Department of Psychology. Dr. Brennan holds the Ph.D. in psychology from Kent State University, and his research is focused on drug interventions in hearing disorders. He has worked for three years in Warsaw Poland under the auspices of the National Academy of Sciences and the Polish Academy of Sciences, and he held a Senior Fulbright Research Fellowship in Pharmacology through the Ministry of Health in Rome. He has published over 60 research articles and 4 books.
